FOUNDATION SCRIPTURE

“A fire shall always be burning on the altar; it shall never go out.”

Leviticus 6:13 NKJV

CENTRAL MESSAGE

God never intended His fire to be occasional. Every believer has a responsibility to tend the altar, protect the flame, and continually feed the fire. A fire starter is not defined by volume, visibility, or emotion, but by a genuine, consecrated relationship with God.

FIVE KEY POINTS

1

FIRE STARTERS REPAIR THE ALTAR

1 Kings 18:30

Before Elijah called down fire, he repaired the broken altar. Revival begins with restoring prayer, worship, repentance, obedience, surrender, and covenant. **Before God changes the atmosphere around us, He restores the altar within us.**

FIRE STARTERS CARRY FIRE WITHIN

Jeremiah 20:9; 2 Timothy 1:6

True spiritual fire begins privately before it is revealed publicly. We must learn to pray, worship, study, and obey even when nobody encourages or applauds us. **We cannot ignite publicly what we refuse to maintain privately.**

FIRE STARTERS CONFRONT WHAT QUENCHES THE FIRE

1 Kings 18:21; 1 Thessalonians 5:19

Compromise, bitterness, pride, fear, distraction, offense, prayerlessness, and disobedience can suppress spiritual fire. We cannot ask God for more fire while protecting what keeps extinguishing it. **Stop protecting what God is trying to burn out of your life.**



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DPMI TEACHING SUMMARY

FIRE STARTERS BURN WHEN NOBODY ELSE DOES

Daniel 3; Revelation 12:11

We must remain faithful when holiness is unpopular, prayer is neglected, and obedience is costly. Like the three Hebrew men, the fire intended to destroy us can reveal the presence of God with us. **Our testimony carries authority because we are speaking from experience, not theory.**

FIRE STARTERS IGNITE OTHERS

Luke 24:32; Acts 1:8; Matthew 5:14

Genuine fire awakens hunger for Jesus. When fire starters pray, worship, speak, and serve, faith rises in others. We were not placed in spiritually cold environments simply to adjust; we were sent there to bring transformation. **We are not called to become the temperature of the room; we are called to carry God's fire into it.**
